Scholarships for Exchange Students

The Baden-Württemberg Stiftung is committed to creating a vibrant Baden-Württemberg by paving the way for cutting-edge research, diverse educational activities and responsible interactions with fellow human beings. One of the means is the scholarship program *Baden-Württemberg-STIPENDIUM for University Students* which is dedicated to promoting the global exchange of high-achieving students from Germany and around the world.

Who can apply?

- Highly qualified students on Bachelor, Master or Ph.D. level from
- partner universities (outside the Erasmus+ Program) who come to Hohenheim within the framework of an exchange agreement for a
- study or research period of a minimum of 3 months (the scholarship is bound to a physical stay in Hohenheim – remote online semesters cannot be funded)
 - The Baden-Württemberg-SCHOLARSHIP cannot be combined with other scholarships of the same scope. In case of doubt, please contact us.

Benefits

- Scholarship of €700/month
 - Maximum funding period: 11 months (10 months for study or research period plus possibly an additional month for participation in the intensive German course in September or March)
 - Maximum funding period might be cut depending on funds available
- Participation in various events offered by the Baden-Württemberg Foundation (meetings, excursions etc.)
- Alumni network

Application procedure

- Potential applicant for the scholarship is selected by the home university according to internal criteria (beside academic performances, social and inter-cultural competences of the applicants can also be considered).
- Nomination - including name, first name, study program and study level - should be e-mailed to us by

April 30, 2021 for stays in the winter semester 2021 or academic year
November 12, 2021 for stays in the summer semester 2022

Later nominations are welcome, provided that scholarships are still available.

- Final decision about the allocation of the scholarships is taken by the Baden-Württemberg Foundation.
