Scholarships for Exchange Students

The Baden-Württemberg-STIPENDIUM for university students is a program established by the Baden-Württemberg Stiftung. The foundation is committed to creating a vibrant Baden-Württemberg by paving the way for cutting-edge research, diverse educational activities and responsible interactions with fellow human beings. The scholarship is thus dedicated to promoting the global exchange of high-achieving students to and from Germany.

Who can apply?

- · Highly qualified students on Bachelor, Master or Ph.D. level from
- partner universities (outside the Erasmus+ Program) who come to Hohenheim within the framework of an exchange agreement for a
- study or research period of a minimum of 3 months (the scholarship is bound to a physical stay in Hohenheim remote online semesters cannot be funded).
 - ➤ The Baden-Württemberg-STIPENDIUM cannot be combined with other scholarships of the same scope. In case of doubt, please contact us.

Benefits

- Scholarship of € 700/month for
- 1 semester (min. 3 months, max. 5 months for a study or research period plus possibly an additional month for participation in the intensive German course in September or March).
 - > Maximum funding period per semester might be cut depending on funds available
 - > Prolongations for a second semester (max. 10 months plus possibly one intensive German course) might be possible. New nominations by the respective deadline are needed.
- · Participation in various events offered by the Baden-Württemberg Stiftung (meetings, excursions etc.)
- · Alumni network

Application procedure

- Potential applicant for the scholarship is selected by the home university according to internal criteria (beside academic performances, social and inter-cultural competences of the applicants can also be considered).
- Nomination including name, first name, study program and study level should be e-mailed to us by

June 3, 2024 for stays in the winter semester 2024/25 or academic year November 15, 2024 for stays in the summer semester 2025

Later nominations are accepted, provided that scholarships are still available.

• Final decision about the allocation of the scholarships is taken by the foundation.
