Standard full time load	15-20 credits per semester (1 credit = 1 semester hour of frontal study).
Course list available to exchange students	All MSc courses at the faculty are taught in English
Course restrictions for incoming students	Most of the courses in the faculty level programs are open to exchange students, pending availability. Participation in some courses requires approval from the department in which the student wishes to study.
Credits and work load	The normal workload for a full-time student is 40 HUJI credits per academic year*. Our credit calculation is based on frontal lecture hours in the semester. HUJI has not adopted the ECTS credits system, however, HUJI credits can be translated into ECTS as follows: 1 HUJI credits x 0.6 = 1 ECTS. (*Varies depending on the field of study)
